

River City on the list of the world's must-visit places

BRISBANE has been named one of the world's hottest tourist destinations by a leading travel bible.

Travel+Leisure has just released its list of the 50 best places to travel in 2020, with Brisbane coming in at No.11 in the rankings. The River City (pictured)

was edged out by Boston in the US for the top 10 while the only other Australian destination to feature in the top 50 was Tasmania at No.48.



It's the latest tourism gong for a city on the move. *Travel+Leisure* gushed about Brisbane's buzzing waterfront and

the air of optimism around Queen's Wharf and a boom of new high-end hotels in the past two years.

Ethiopia's blossoming capital Addis Ababa was named No.1 ahead of Arequipa in Peru and the arty American city of Asheville. Austria, Barbados, Beijing, Hawaii's Big Island and Mexico's Baja Sur also featured in the top 10.
