RIVER PRECINCT TO BE A FEAST OF FINE DINING

SOME of the biggest names in Australian hospitality have promised to deliver a dining destination unlike anything else in the world at Brisbane's new Howard Smith Wharves.

Acclaimed Sydney restaurateurs Matt Yazbek and Jonathan Barthelmess, along with Brisbane hospitality king Andrew Barturo, have announced that they

will be launching their most exciting venues to date at the new riverfront precinct, underneath the Story Bridge, when it kicks off from late November.

Originally constructed in the 1930s,



the 3.4ha heritage site on the Brisbane River will feature up to eight restaurants.

The development will also feature the impressive 600sq m octagonal-shaped Overwater Bar, which will float above the Brisbane River, as well as the brewery and eatery Felons Brewing Co.

HSW director Adam Flaskas said the lifestyle and entertainment zone would become a huge drawcard for locals as well as interstate and overseas visitors.
